Dr Hobday is a Principal Research Scientist at CSIRO Marine and Atmospheric Research. His research spans a range of topics, including spatial management and migration of large pelagic species, environmental influences on marine species, and the impacts of climate change on marine resources.

He leads the Marine Climate Impacts area within the CSIRO Climate Adaptation Flagship, and has been co-editor of two recent reports on the impacts of climate change on (1) fisheries and aquaculture, and (2) Australian marine life. He contributed to the development of the Marine National Adaptation Research Plan, co-leads the Biodiversity and Resources theme in the National Climate Change Adaptation Research Facility (NCCARF) Marine Network and is co-chair of the international Climate Impacts on Top Ocean Predators program.
